Department of Homeland Security and other federal, state and local organizations that are engaged in homeland security efforts. We have an occasional breakfast meeting.

We strive for a setting that fosters open conversations between WHSR members and the DHS representative to establish how industry can better serve the needs of DHS in the specific department or mission area being represented.
